

## Staple City

1. Use at least 15 visible sets of staples in all photos. You are welcome to use more!
2. Shoot as many photos as you would like. You are required to upload your ten best photos.
3. Pay careful attention to composition and background. There shouldn't be any reflections from the overhead lights, flashlights, etc.
4. Remember, to experiment with the angles from which you shoot.
5. At least three of your photos should convey a "mood". The mood should be identified via captions on your blog.
6. Use your cell phone flashlight to create drama and interest in these low light photos. You may also use colored tissue or objects. Be mindful that you are working to create a scene that is fairly realistic.
7. As always, all photos should be well composed, focused, and properly exposed.
8. Create a Google slideshow of 11 slides. The first slide should include your full name. For the next 10 slides, insert one photo per slide.
9. Upload your slideshow to Google Classroom and submit your work.
